## Climate and Biodiversity – Nordic Youth Seminar 2025

### General information

The seminar will be hosted at Scandic Segevång, *Segesvången, 212 27 Malmö, Sweden*. Arrival time is 7<sup>th</sup> of February at 16.15 and the seminar ends February 9<sup>th</sup> at 15.30.

We will be approximately 100 people participating from the Nordic countries (Greenland, Iceland, Faroe Islands, Denmark, Sweden, Norway, and Finland). The main language will be English, but we encourage and appreciate it if you are curious and willing to try to communicate in the Nordic languages as much as possible.

### Common transportation to the seminar

We have booked buses between the seminar and Malmö station as well as between the seminar and Copenhagen Airport.

The departure and arrival times are as follows:

Departure from Copenhagen Airport on Friday the 7<sup>th</sup> of February at 15.45

Departure from Malmö Station on Friday the 7<sup>th</sup> of February at 16.00

Departure from the seminar on Sunday the 9<sup>th</sup> of February at 15.30 arriving at Copenhagen Airport at 16.00

Departure from the seminar on Sunday the 9<sup>th</sup> of February at 15.30 arriving at Malmö station at 15.45

If you have chosen that we should book your transportation for you, you are automatically signed up for the buses.

If you are booking your transportation yourself, you have received a link to a Form where you can sign up for using the buses as well. If you have not signed up yet, please do so here:

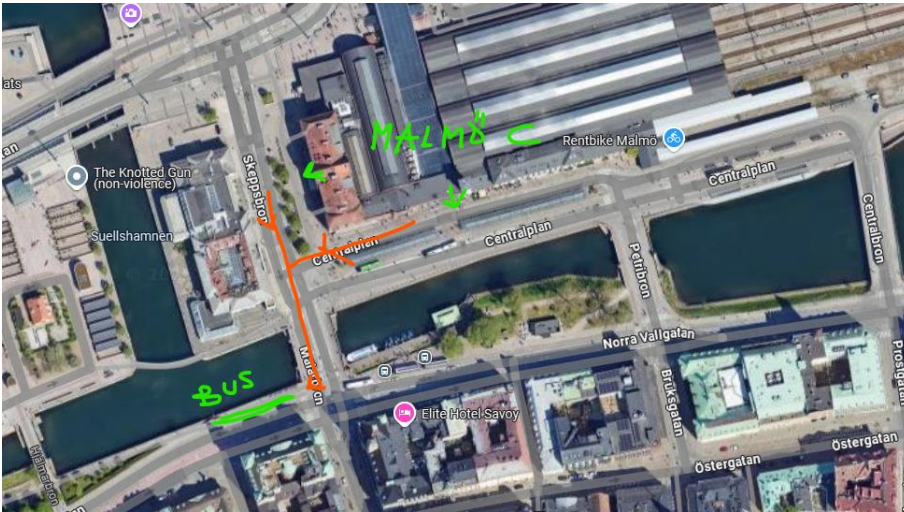

### How do I find the buses?

At Copenhagen Airport, the bus will be parked outside of Terminal 3. There are signs in the arrival hall for “Taxi and Charterbus”. Below is a picture showing where the bus will be parked.



At Malmö station, the bus will be parked on Norra Vallgatan:



### **Check in and arrival at Scandic Segevång**

We will wait for you in the reception, as you arrive at Scandic Segevång. Here you will need to check in with us, so that we know you are here, and so you can get your keycard for your room.

#### On arrival at Scandic Segevång, you must:

- Hand in your signed Code of Behavior
- Receive the keycard to your room
- Make your own nametag

All participants will stay at Scandic Segevång, where the seminar is hosted as well. You will stay in a room either alone or together with one other participant of the same gender, as you have noted in your application form.
