

DEGREES OF YOUTH PARTICIPATION

8. Youth-initiated and directed:

Youth have the orginial idea and decide how it is carried out.

7. Youth-initiated, shared decisions:

Youth have the original idea and consult with 'adults' on how to carry it out.

6. Adult-initiated with participation from youth:

'Adults' have the original idea and youth are involved in planning and implementation.

5. Youth consulted and informed:

Youth are consulted and theiropinions are taken seriously.

4. Assigned and informed:

'Adults' decide on the project and youth volunteer for it.

3. Tokenism:

Youth are consulted but their opinions are not taken seriously

2. Decoration:

Youth take part in a limited capacity and have no role in decision-making.

1. Manipulation:

Youth do as directed but do not understand or have influence over the project.
